Welcome to the September edition of the Newsletter!

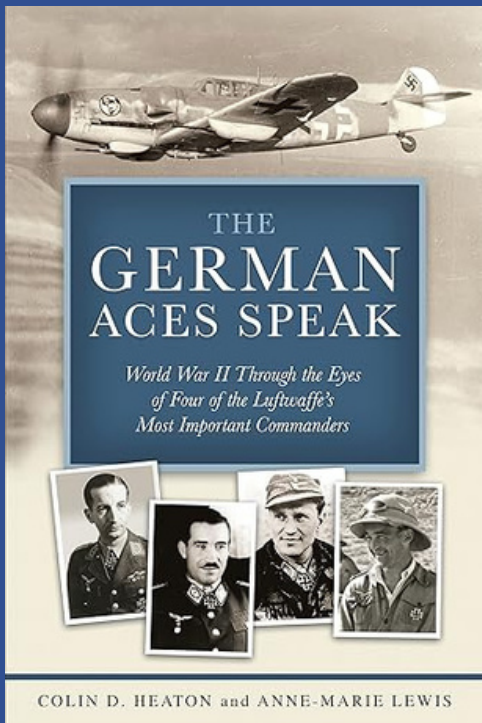

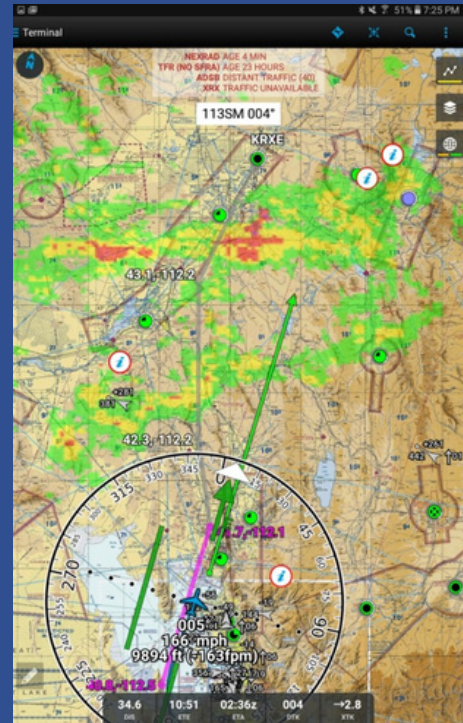
